Guidelines for paper presenters:

1. All submissions should be in MS word format
2. Abstract of the original research/conceptual papers and empirical studies/case studies briefly describing objectives, methodology, major results and its implications. The abstract must not exceed 500 words.
3. The length of the final submission should not exceed 5000 words, excluding footnotes.
4. The abstract and the final submission must be typed in Times New Roman, with font size 12 and 1.5 line spacing.
5. APA (American Psychological Association) (6th ed.) must be strictly adhered to while submitting the abstract and the final submission.

Presentation:

Authors of selected articles will be invited to present their paper in National Seminar on 4th and 5th September, 2017. The presentation will be followed by question answer-round conducted by expert panel. Please note that only selected articles will be considered for presentation. However, some papers would also be selected for publishing after further screening.
